
For Playback of Recorded Video



To view recorded video use these controls.




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This is your calendar, located in the bottom right corner of the main playback screen.




Choose the day you wish to review by clicking on its number. Your available days will be bold. The days not bold are not available for review.

To change the current month displayed, use these arrows.

This is where you can select the exact time of the day to be viewed. The time is also in military time. Hours : minutes : seconds.

Once you have selected the time and the day click the GOTO button to take you there.

This is the camera activity field. You can click anywhere in this field.



Select this to change time increments on grey time display bar.


Slider for scrolling time frame viewable in activity field.


Scroll up or down to view the activity for additional cameras.

Time Display Bar

In order to save a video clip you will need to write down the start time and finish time of the video you wish to save. An example of this is camera 2 09:56 start and 09:59 end.



Now that you have the desired start time, finish time and the camera numbers that you want to save, make sure you hit the pause button and then click the backup button. This is the screen that appears over the main screen when you hit the backup button.



If you plan on sending someone a recording you will have to check AVI so they do not need this program to view the clip.

Enter the start time and date you want to save.

Enter the end time and date of the video you want to save.


The file can be password protected if you wish.

Check the cameras you want to save.

Once you have entered the start time, the end time and selected the cameras, and password protected the file.....click this button.

This is the next window you will see pop up when that button is selected.

After you have selected a location and a name for the file, click the start button and your video will be saved.



Now enter the location and the name of the file you are saving and then click Save.
